Dear Chief Financial Officer:

This organization's Charities registration is approved to solicit contributions in its first year of operation. However, the organization must file an amended initial Charities registration with actual financial figures within six month of Its first fiscal year end date shown above. When filing an amended registration, please be aware of the following:

If your organization raised more than \$25,000 in gross contributions in Its last fiscal year, or if It contracted with a professional fund raiser, Form CRI-1501 must be submitted. If the IRS required your organization to file a 990/EZ/PF, a copy must be submitted to this Office.

- If your organization is Long Form filer and received over \$500,000 in total gross revenue during the fiscal year being reported, a certified audit must be submitted to this Office.
- If you have not already done so, submit a copy of the IRS determination letter when it is received from the IRS.

Pursuant to the Charitable Registration and Investigation Act, N.J.S.A. 45:17A-18 et seq. (the CRI Act), and Its accompanying regulations, N.J.A.C. 13:48-1 et seq. you may refer to the above charitable registration number and proceed as an organization registered to solicit funds in this State.

Your registration number will remain the same from year to year and must appear on all forms, documents, payments and correspondence sent to this office. The CRI Act requires charities to renew their registration annually by filling a renewal registration statement and fee, along with required document copies. Your annual renewal registrations are due six (6) months after your organization's fiscal year end and your next renewal date is show above. Should your registration lapse for failure to renew by the annual due date, you must immediately cease and desist from using the registration number (per **N.J.S.A.** 13:48-3.1(g)).
